When? Key Events and Dates		
1949	Albert the space monkey (NASA)	The first monkey is sent to space. His name was Albert II. He was a Rhesus monkey and he flew 83 miles away from Earth!
1957	Sputnik (ROSCOSMOS)	On the 4th October Russia launched Sputnik., the first satellite into space. Sputnik means 'satellite' in Russian.
	Laika the space dog (ROSCOSMOS)	Laika the Russian space dog became the first animal to orbit the Earth. Her name means 'barker' in Russian!
1961	Yuri Gagarin — Ist man in Space (ROSCOSMOS)	Yuri Gagarin was the first man in space.
1962	John Glenn — 3 orbits of Earth (NASA)	Johm Glenn was the first American to orbit the Earth.
1969	Moon Landing (NASA)	Three astronauts were sent into space with the mission of being the first people to land on the moon, it was a success. Neil Armstrong took his first steps on the moon four days later while the world watched on their TV screens. On July 24th, they returned home as heroes after a very successful mission.
2015	Tim Peake (ESA)	Tim Peake is a famous British astronaut. He lived on board the International Space Station for six months, in 2016 where he carried out experiments and completed space walks.
