When? Key Events and Dates		
1926	Princess Elizabełh is born	Princess Elizabeth was born on 21st April 1926 in Mayfair, London. She was the first child of The Duke and Duchess of York, who later became King George VI and Queen Elizabeth.
1947	Princess Elizabeth Marries Prince Phillip	Princes Elizabeth got married at Westminster Abbey on 20th November 1947, when she was 21 years old. She married Prince Phillip, also known as the Duke of Edinburgh, who was the son of Prince Andrew of Greece.
1953	The Queen's Coronation	Princess Elizabeth's father, King George VI, died when she was just 25. Princess Elizabeth was in Kenya when she heard the sad news. She immediately returned home and was proclaimed Queen Elizabeth II two days later. Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II's coronation took place in 1953 at Westminster Abbey in London.
2002	Golden Jubilee celebrations	The Queen celebrates 50 years of service.
2011	William and Kate get married	Prince William, the Queens Grandson, and heir to the throne married Kate at Westminster Abbey.
2021	Prince Phillip dies	Prince Philips dies at the age of 99. He was buried at Windsor Castle.
2022	Platinum Jubilee celebrations The Queen dies	In 2022, Queen Elizabeth II celebrated her Platinum Jubilee. The occasion marked 70 years since she became Queen of the United Kingdom and the Commonwealth of Nations. She was the first British monarch to reach this milestone. In September 2022 Queen Elizabeth II dies. At the time of her death, she had reigned for 70 years. Charles was proclaimed King Charles III.
2023	The King's Coronation	King Charles was coronated on Saturday 6 th May 2023. The coronation took place at Westminster Abbey.
